




IRC Certificate Program




National Seminar on Plagiarism-Free Report Writing Techniques


National Level Workshop on Data Analysis Techniques in Social Science Research using SPSS & AMOS


Faculty Internship at Prashanth Designs


Orientation Programme for Faculty Members






PG Orientation Program


Outbound Training Programme




Selection of Cadets
