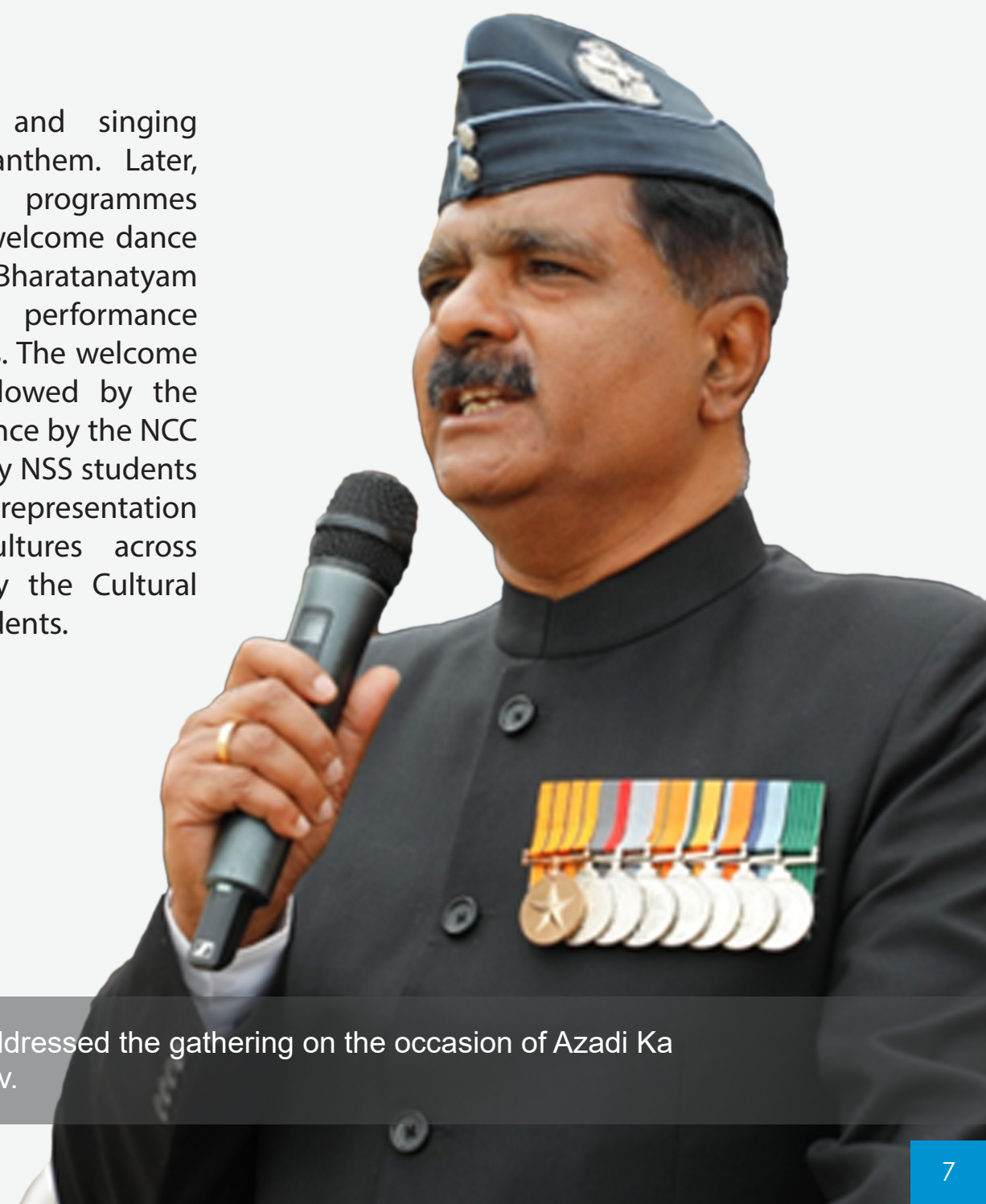
# INDEPENDENCE DAY

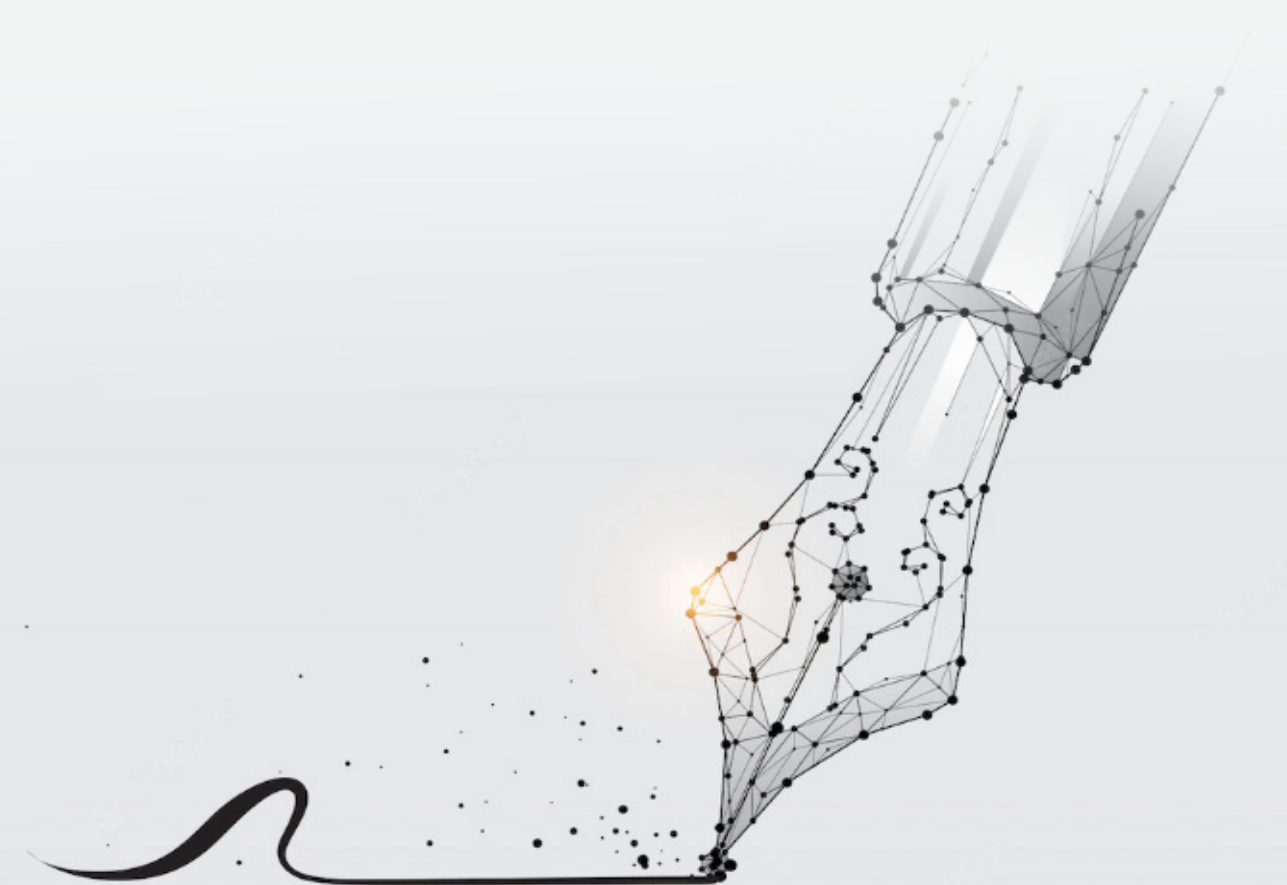
event was well organized and appreciated by the Commanding Officer and gathering.

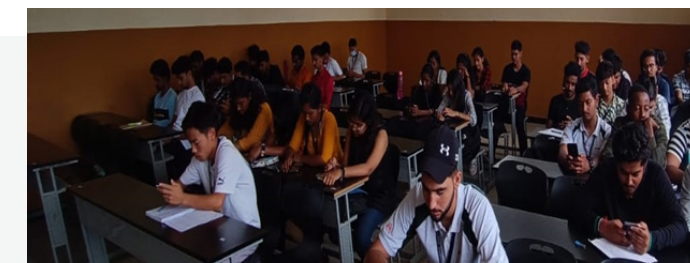

## Internship and Placement opportunities



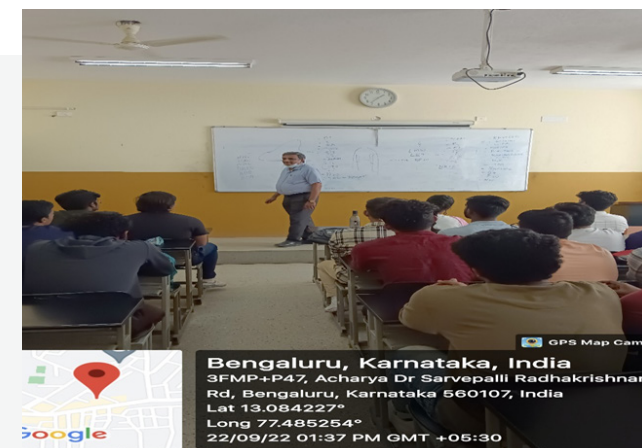

## ENHANCING THE READING SKILLS

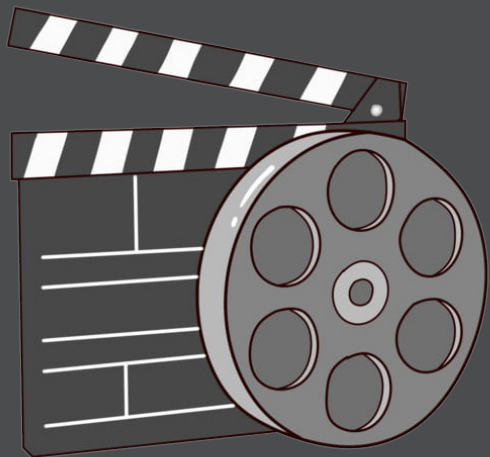

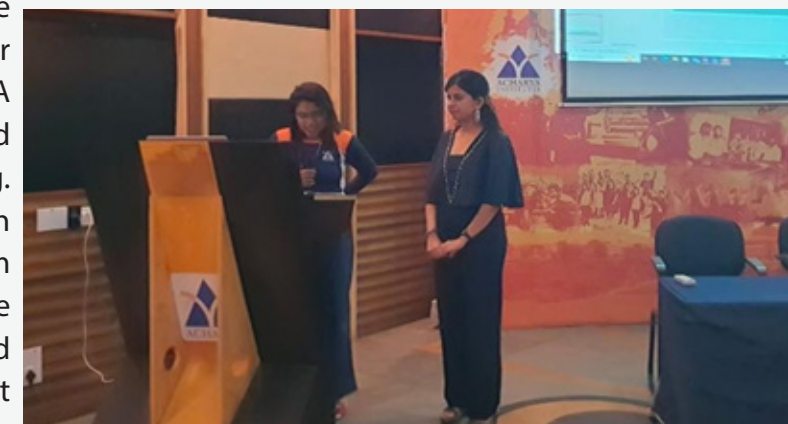


## "FASHION BLOGGING" CONDUCTED BY DEPT. OF FASHION AND APPAREL DESIGN

The talk was highly interactive, enriching, informative and relevant for the students. The students were encouraged to ask questions and put forth their viewpoints throughout the entire session.

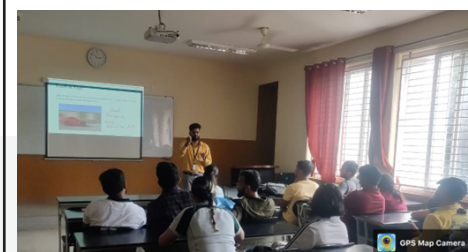
## GUEST TALK ON AIR FARE AND AIR TICKETING

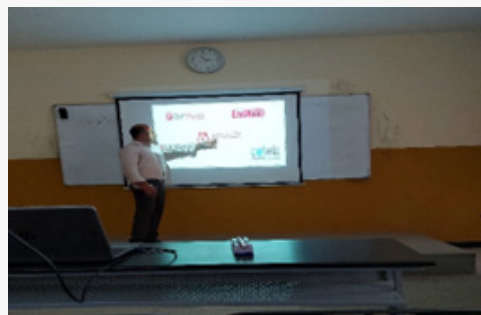

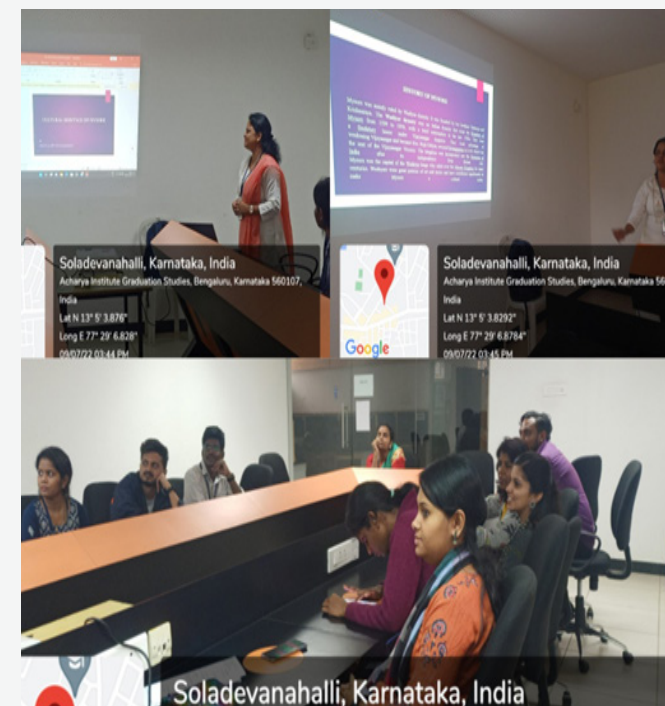
came to a close after a long healthy discussion on education system and its different versions.

## INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY AWARENESS PROGRAMME

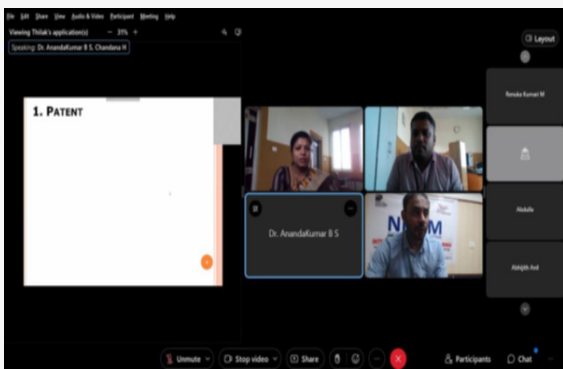
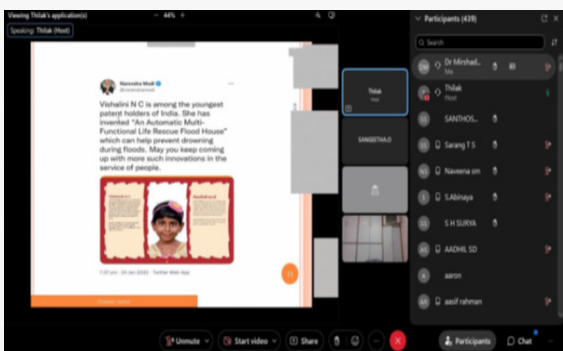
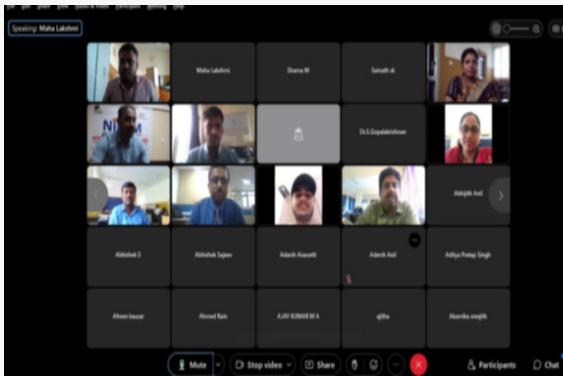

The speakers of the session were Mr. Abhishek Singh and Mr. Thilak Vadicherla, Examiner

of Patents and Design, Patent office Chennai, Ministry of Industry and Commerce. The session was related to different Issues and Challenges associated with patent, copy right and trademark. A total of about 907 participants took part in the program which included faculty members and students across Acharya Institutes of Graduate Studies.

It created a great impact on the entire audience. Students were taught on how IPR restricts copying others' ideas and how this will help the development of new ideas for the betterment of the society. Highlighting the importance of documenting ideas properly and patenting it, they said that in the coming years the country will be known for its scientific creations in different fields ranging from agriculture to space research.

IPR sought to protect intangible creations of the human intellect which are beneficial to the society. We have to protect intellectual property and it cannot be done in a manner we generally adopt for physical property. Students learnt how IPR provides total control over a new innovation and its creator. They were also given a platform to discuss how a small innovations influence society at large and how they should indulge in innovating and patenting ideas that will be useful for all the classes of individual in the society.



## VALUE ADDED WORKSHOP ON PREVENTION OF INTERPERSONAL ABUSE AND VIOLENCE



The Department of Psychology conducted a two day workshop on "Prevention of Interpersonal Abuse and Violence: Psychological and Legal Perspective" for the PG Psychology students on 03 and 04 August 2022, at the Seminar Hall, AES block. The resource persons for the workshop were Dr. N.V Ashwini, Director, Muktha Foundation who spoke on the Psychological Perspectives and Mr. Alwyn Sebastian, Legal Consultant, Muktha Foundation who spoke on the Legal Perspectives

The workshop on the first day was on the Psychological Perspectives of prevention of interpersonal abuse and violence. The resource person for the day was Dr. Ashwini N.V. She discussed different forms of abuse and two broad categories of child sexual abuse. She also enlightened the audience on Dr. Michael Welner's model, potential warning signs of abuse, myths regarding child sexual abuse, safety guidelines, smart

acronyms, bullying, and abuse in workplace. The resource person for the second day of workshop was Mr. Alwyn Sebastian, Legal Consultant at Muktha Foundation, partner at TSA Legal. The focus of Mr. Alwyn Sebastian's session was the legal aspects of prevention of interpersonal abuse and violence. He commenced the session with a brief history of Indian legal aspects. He discussed the IPC sections related to abuse and violence. Particular emphasis was placed on IPC Section 498 A which prohibits abuse and harassment of women by law. Mr. Alwyn also threw light upon loopholes in the legal systems that allow offenders to get away and provided insight into how the same could be avoided with stricter laws. The resource persons were extremely knowledgeable and put forth complex material in a lucid manner that could be comprehended by beginners in the field. The session was highly informative and able to provide a wealth of information on a relatively new area for the students.

### WORKSHOP ON HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT AND ORGANIZATIONAL DEVELOPMENT

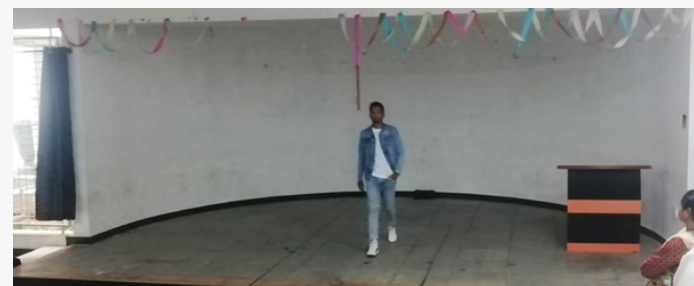

in three rounds - Aptitude Test, Group Discussion, and Personal interview. A total of 69 candidates applied and finally 9 students were selected for the available positions.

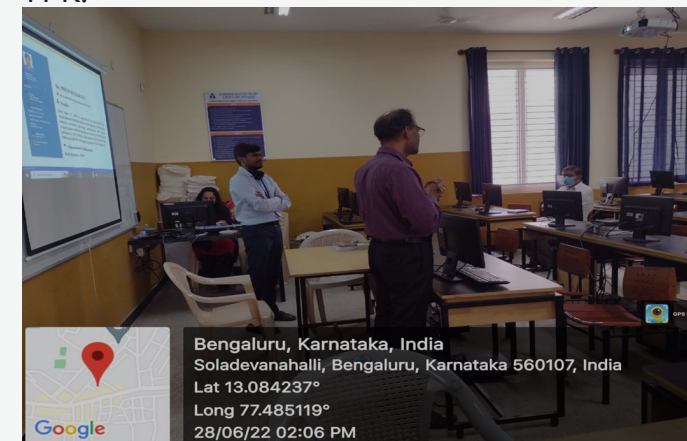


## FDP on Course Outcomes and Programme Outcomes

## ALUMNI INTERACTION ON BRAND ESTABLISHMENT AND PORTFOLIO, SUSTAINABLE FASHION

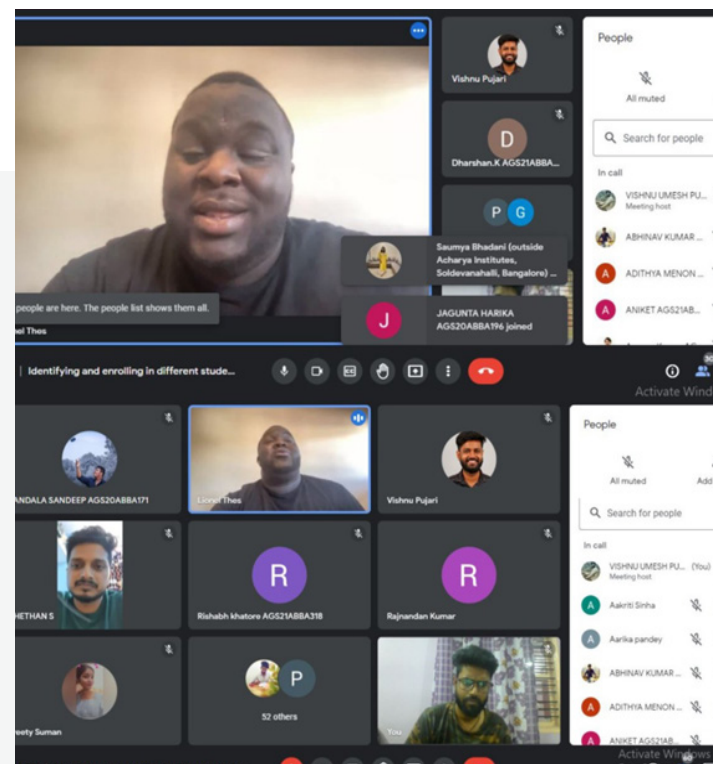

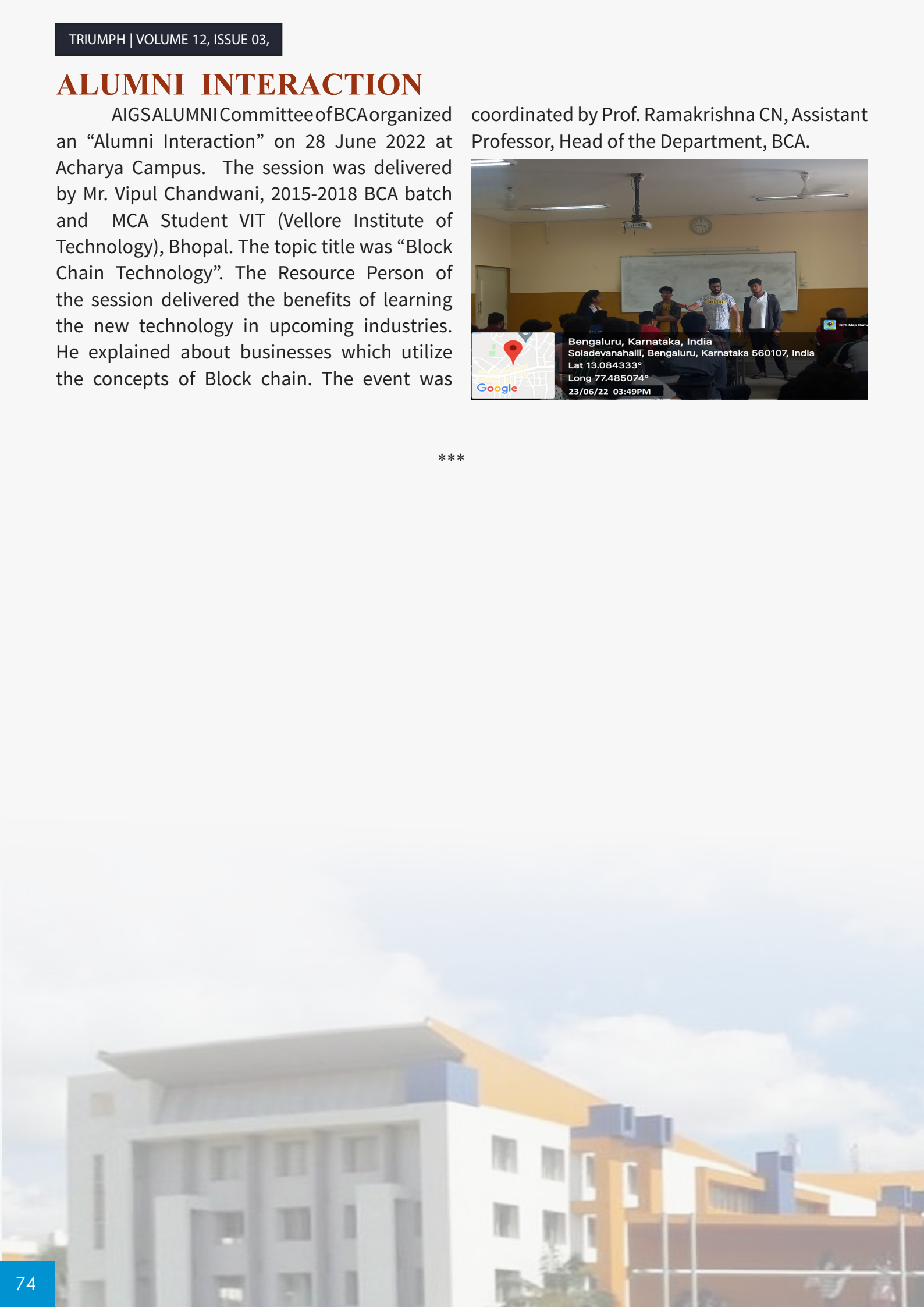
# ALUMNI INTERACTION
