The Department of Social Work AIGS organised a one day awareness program on 'LEPROSY' on 20 January 2023. The program focused on creating awareness among students about Leprosy. The session addressed the various activities initiated by Sumanhalli leprosy centre to combat leprosy. The resource persons for the event were Fr Dr George Kannathanam, Director, Sumanhalli leprosy Center, Aadhi Sir Overall Coordinator, Masthan Sir, Sister Cristina (Staff members of Sumanhalli Leprosy Center) Mariamma and Pakirappa. (Inamtes from Sumanhalli Leprosy Center).

The session threw light on how Leprosy is a neglected tropical disease which still occurs in more than 120 countries, with more than 200 000 new cases reported every year. The main objective of the awareness program was to help students in learning early detection and management of patients with leprosy. The session was able to create awareness and respond to students' negative perception about the disease. The awareness program also helped the social work trainees in explaining the public health interventions to reduce disease burden and essential indicators and manage disabilities.

## POT-PAINTING COMPETITION

The objective of the activity was to bring out the overall creativity and individual talent exhibition in a diversified way. Girija also shared her personal experience which made her to take up this initiative of creating awareness in schools and colleges. Towards the end of the session, a short movie on the importance of following road safety rules prepared by NSS alumni was screened which was appreciated by the audience the chief guests. The whole team of around 150 NSS volunteers took an oath to follow the road safety rules and they received their certificate for the same by the Govt. of Karnataka.

## Extension Activity on “Child Assessment & Intervention”

The PG Department of Psychology, Acharya Institute of Graduate Studies, conducted an Extension Activity at RC International School, Bengaluru, by the students of II Semester M.Sc Psychology on 29-31 October 2022.

The group of 13 students accompanied by faculty from the Dept of Psychology Mr. Mohd Swaroop and Ms. Sonal Mahadik arrived at RC International School at 1 pm on 29th October and commenced the assessments with the students provided by the school. Students took turns in administering tests that included assessment of cognitive abilities like Knox Cube Imitation Test, Wechsler's Intelligence Scale for Children (WISC IV), assessment of personality like Children's Apperception Test (CAT) and Children's Personality Questionnaire (CPQ) along with screening tests of academic performance like the NIMHANS SLD battery.

The students visited the school on Monday 31st October as well and performed assessments till the school closed at 4 pm. The tests were conducted on students of grade 4 - grade 9 who were identified by the school as needing assessment in various areas. Under the guidance of their faculty, students of II Semester MSc learnt to establish rapport with children,



make them feel comfortable, give appropriate instructions, administer tests, record and score their responses, and write a comprehensive report of the findings to be duly submitted to the school. In conclusion, the extension activity fulfilled its objectives as the students learnt administration of various assessments in a real world scenario.

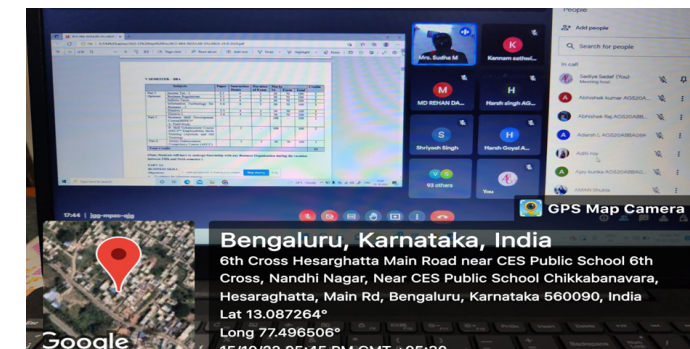

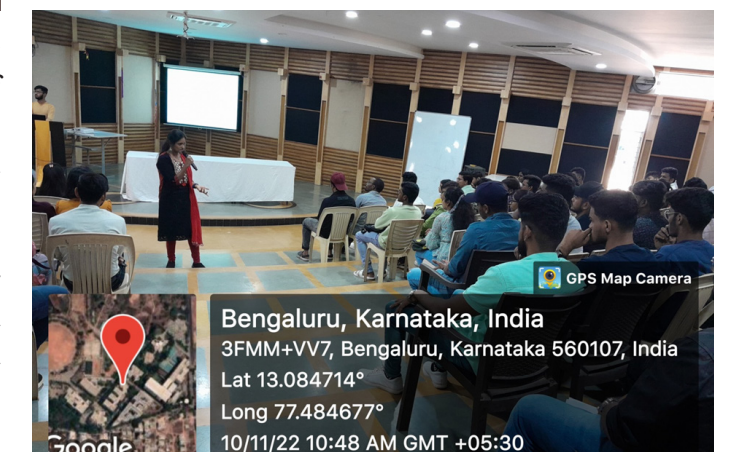

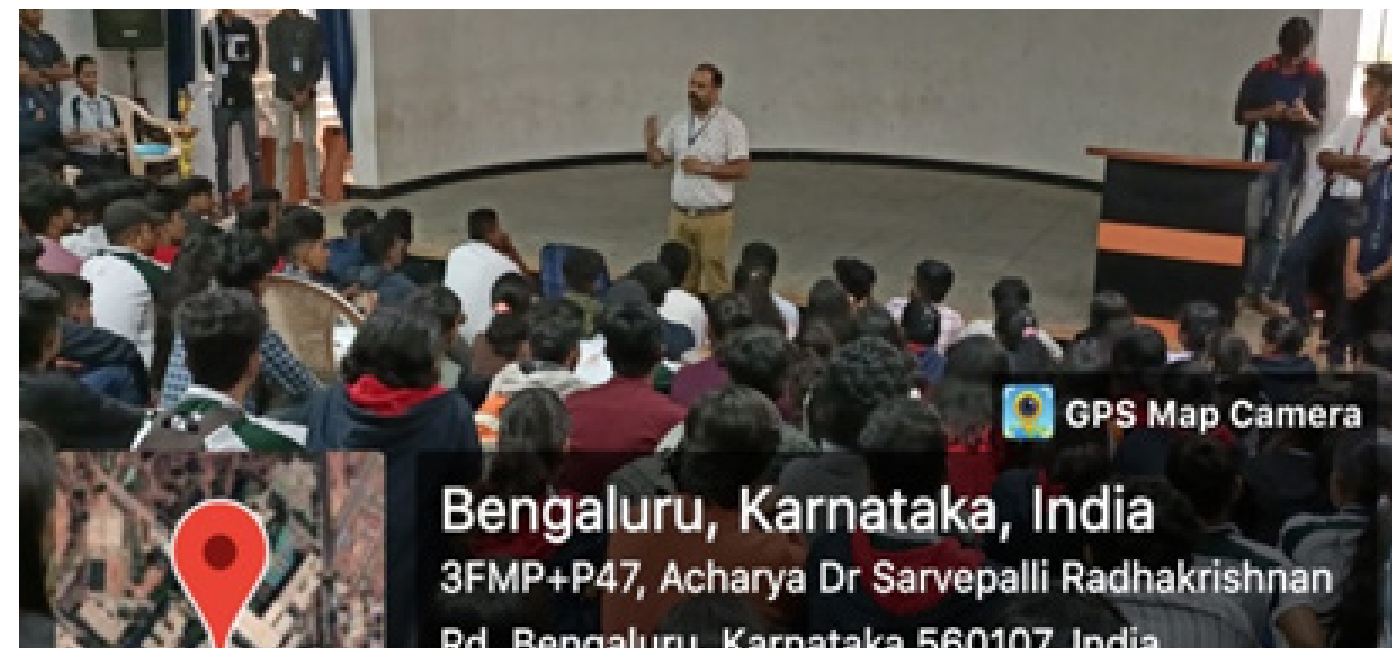


On 29 December 2022, the Department of Management organized an orientation on certificate programs. The final year BBA students were given orientation on Excel and Tally

were requested to conduct few more training programs like this.

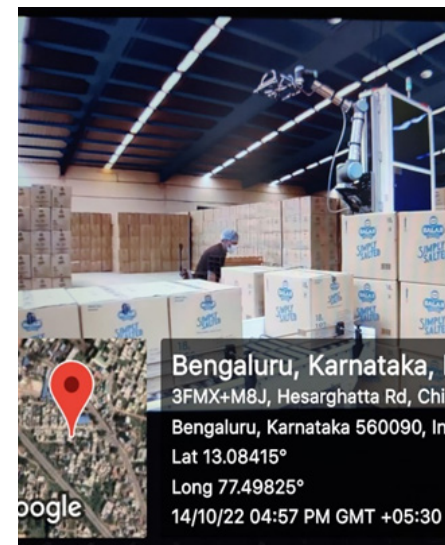
## REPORT ON KNOWLEDGE SHARING SESSION

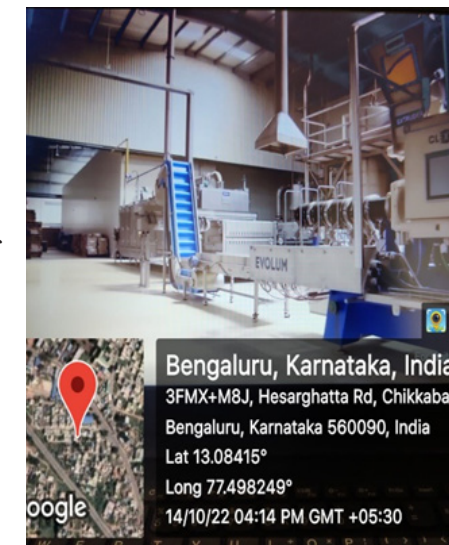

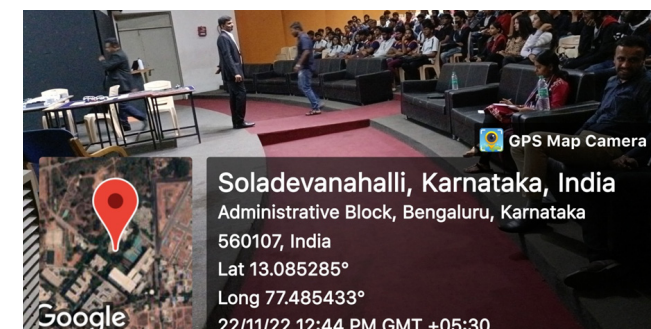

## Report on “Innovation and Leadership”

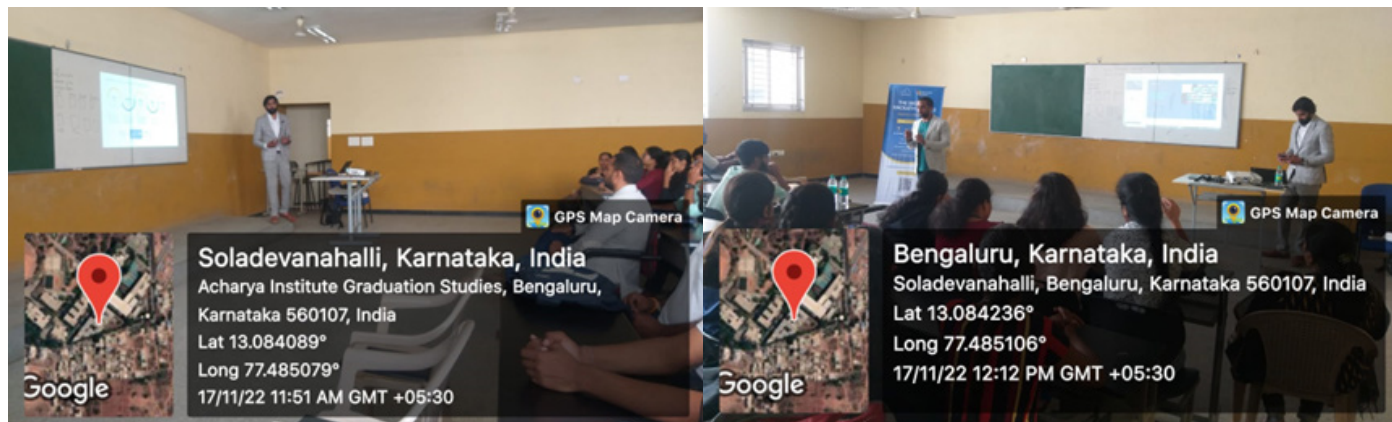

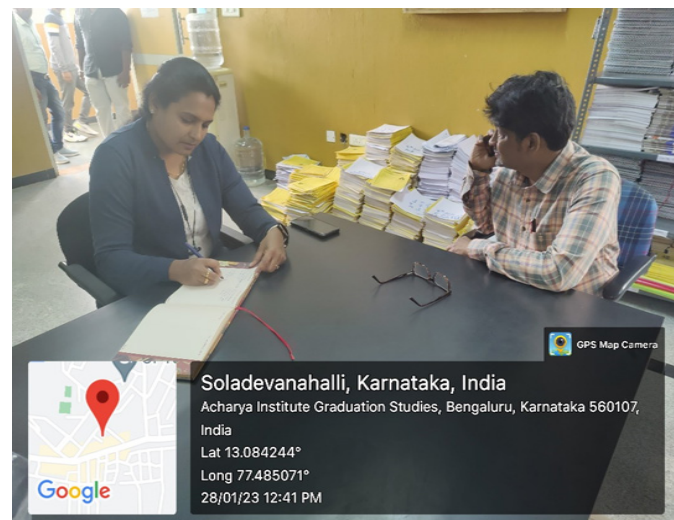

## Guest Talk on “Database Management System and MS Access”

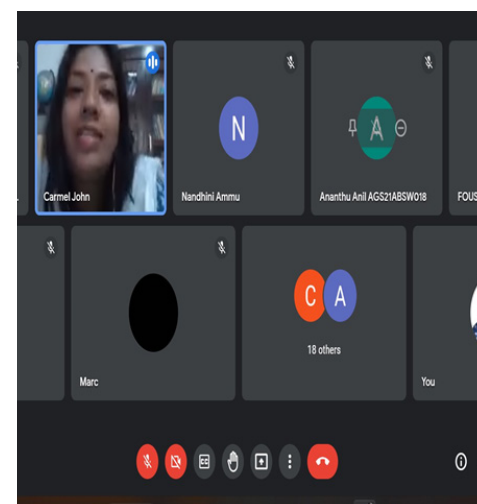

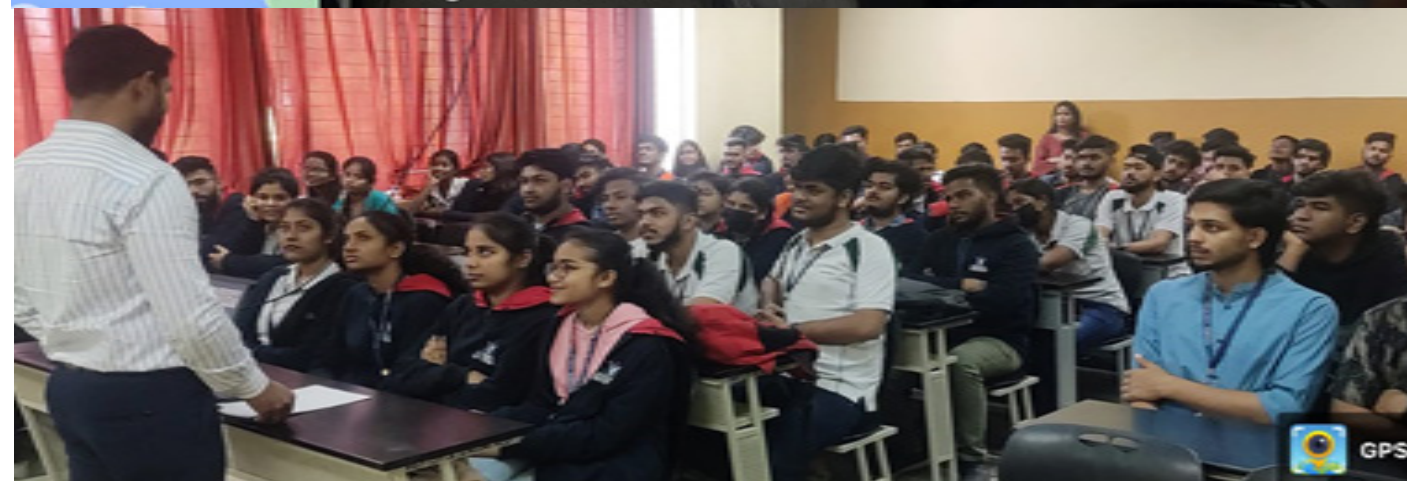
## GUEST TALK ON ECONOMICS OF ENTREPRENEUR

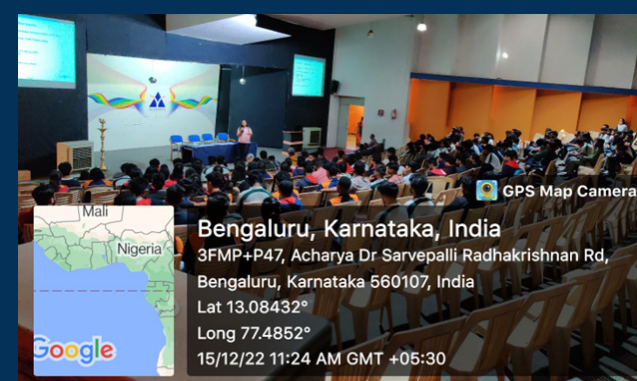


## GUEST TALK ON OPPORTUNITIES IN ABROAD

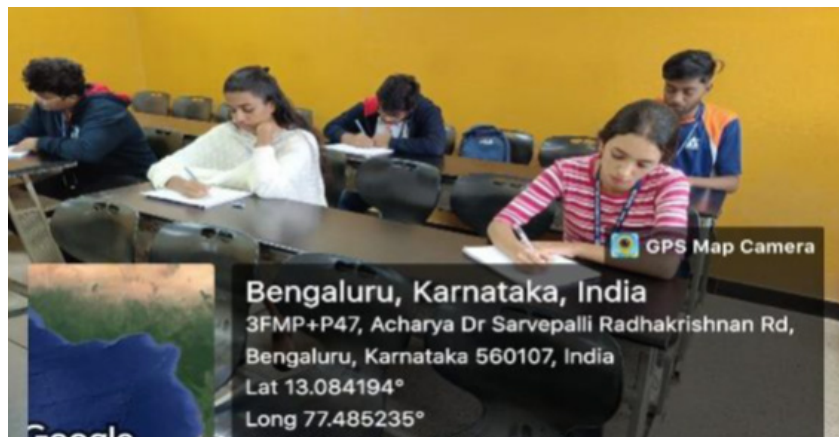

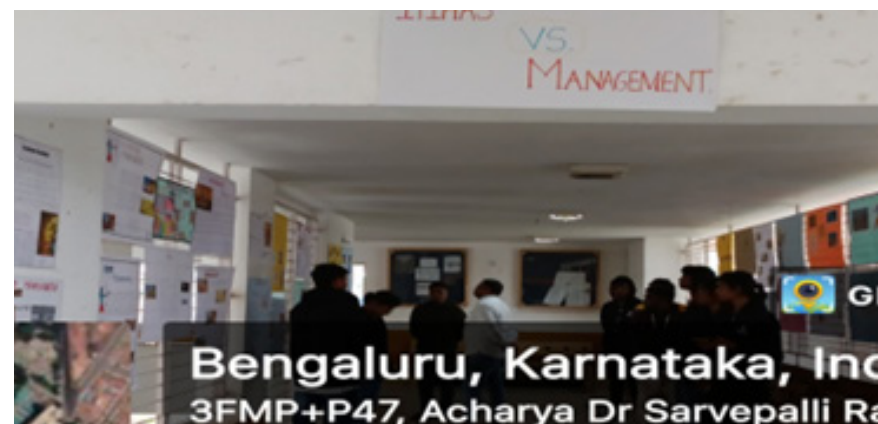
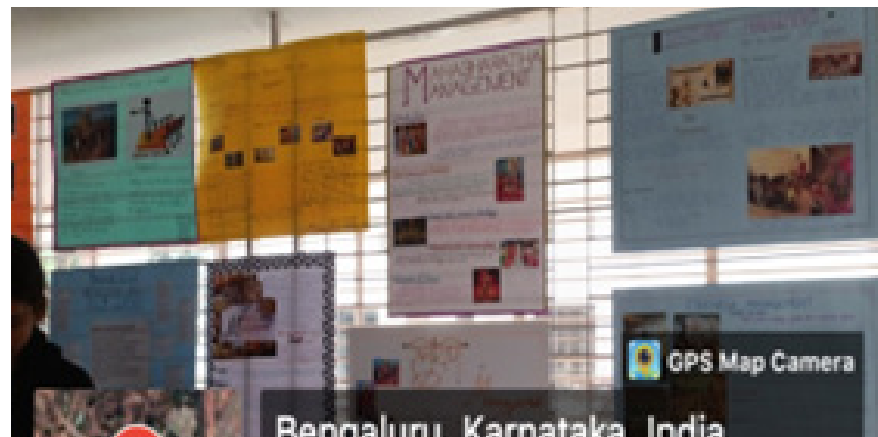


## ESSAY COMPETITION

## VISIT TO RESERVE BANK OF INDIA

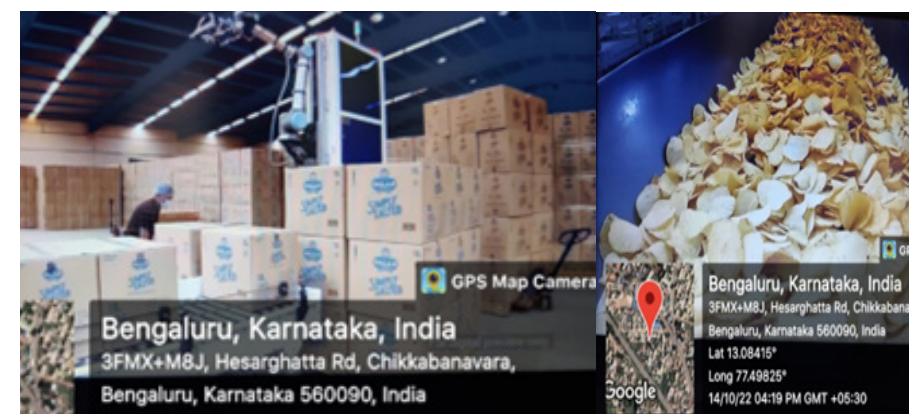

## INDUSTRY VISIT TO KARNATAKA CHITRAKALA PARISHATH

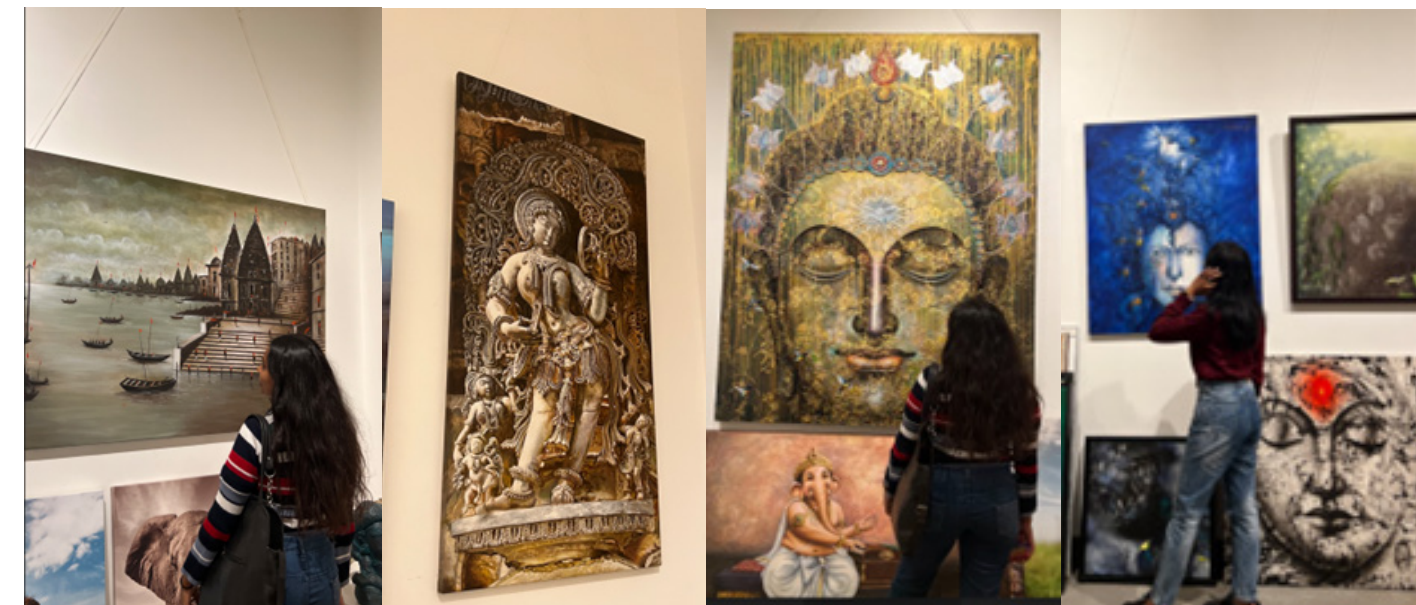

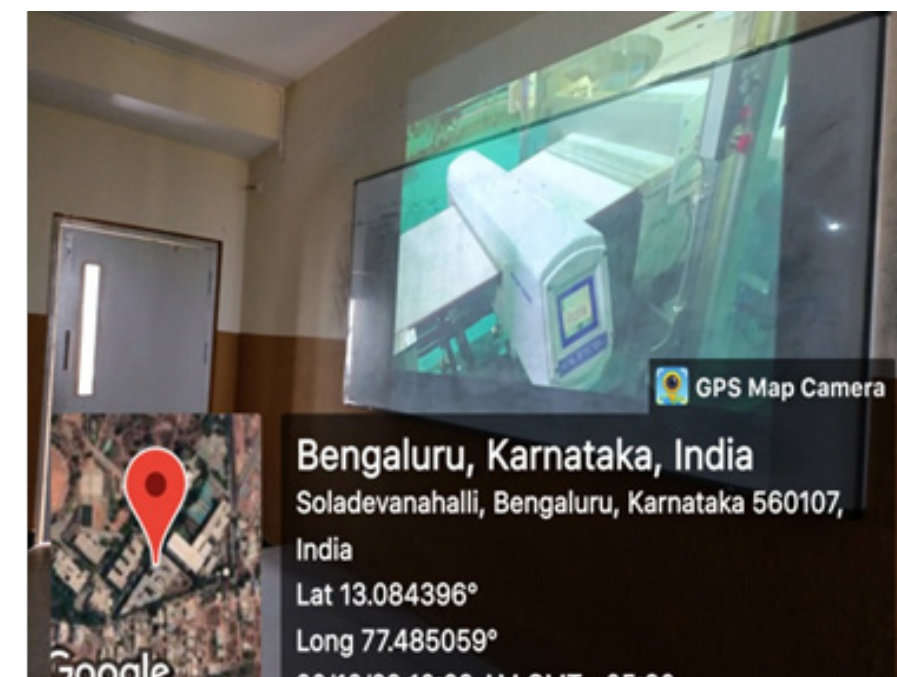

The workshop was facilitated by Dr. Jini K. Gopinath, Clinical Psychologist & Certified Hypnotherapist, Chief Psychology Officer at Your Dost Academy, Bengaluru. The workshop began with Mr. Anish of II Semester M.Sc Psychology welcoming the gathering and later the resource person, Dr. JiniGopinath took over the session and began introducing the concepts, origins and relevance of Hypnosis. He began by clearing myths and misconceptions surrounding hypnosis, trance like states, and how hypnosis evolved into the current practice it is today from the early days of



of Mesmer. Using a demonstration with 5 volunteers, he was able to show how different people have different levels of suggestibility, or as he called it, hypnotizability, and one would have to modulate ones approach depending on these varying levels. With a theoretical foundation, he was able to explain the role of the unconscious and subconscious in perception, and its pervading effect on our lives, the former in pathology, the latter in suggestion, and how it forms

the premise for hypnosis. DrJini expressed how hypnotherapy is used as an adjunct with psychotherapy, and how one could even create an eclectic modality of treatment using hypnotherapy and drawing from other established schools of thought. Further, with the help of some more volunteers, DrJini demonstrated some more techniques in hypnotherapy, from formulating a case to case, to emphasis on the suggestions provided, the tone of voice, the prosody of words, repetition of crucial instructions, and forming sentences for instruction for different people with different temperament. Supported by anecdotes of his own clinical experience, the resource person was able to paint an articulate picture of the clinical practice of hypnotherapy to the students.

# WORKSHOP ON WASTE MANAGEMENT

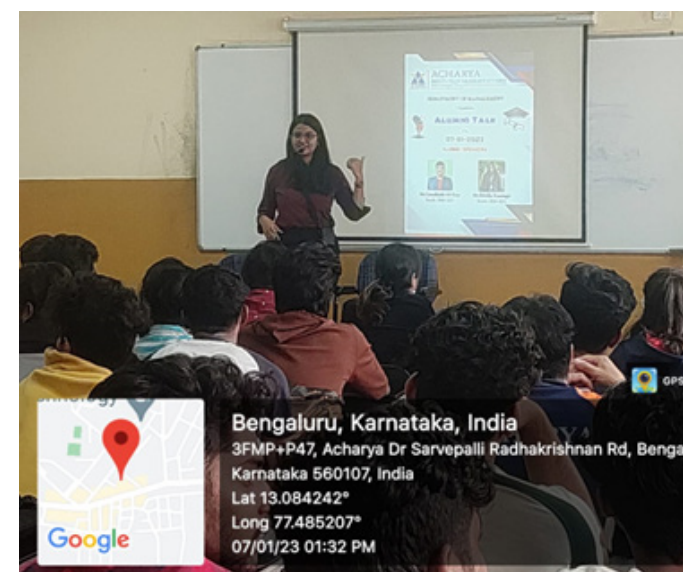

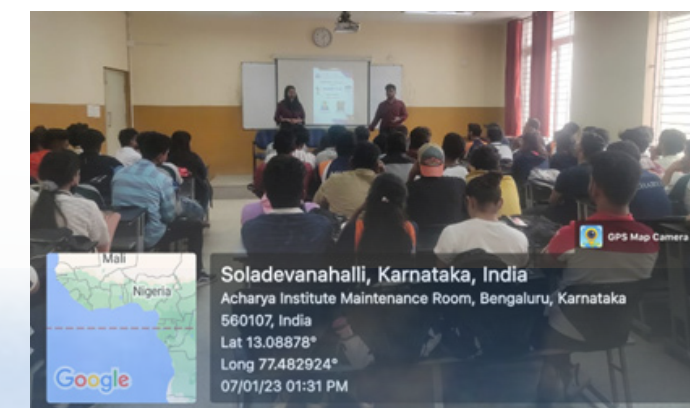


## Alumni Talk on Career Opportunities; Do's and Don'ts in College Life
