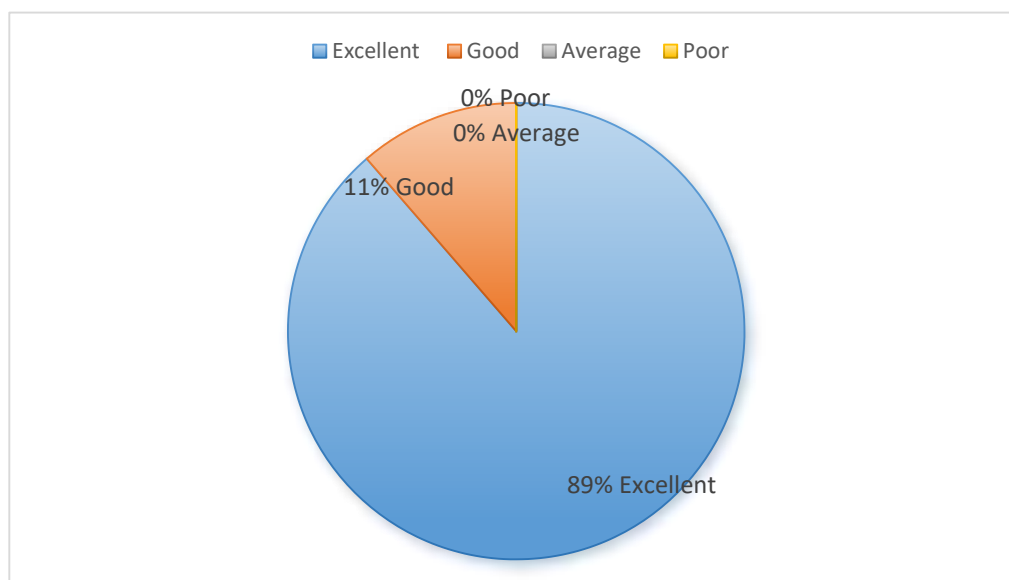


participate actively and celebrate the occasion in a joyful manner. These activities helped create a friendly and energetic atmosphere among the participants.
