The event was open to candidates from diverse educational backgrounds, ranging from 10th standard to Postgraduate level, including both freshers and experienced professionals.

The initiative aimed to bridge the gap between academia and industry by providing direct access to recruiters, enabling candidates to explore career opportunities and participate in on-the-spot recruitment processes.

With participation from candidates across Karnataka, the event served as an inclusive employment platform, supporting both institutional and government-driven employment initiatives.

Detailed Report:

1.RegistrationProcess

Candidates registered through both online platforms and on-spot registration counters at the venue. Volunteers and placement coordinators assisted candidates throughout the registration process to ensure smooth flow and minimal waiting time. A total of 1281 candidates registered, including 1060 online registrations and 221 on-spot registrations, indicating strong participation.

2.Company Participation & Recruitment Process

A total of 24 companies from various sectors participated in the job fair, offering diverse job roles. Candidates directly interacted with HR representatives, attended interviews, and explored multiple opportunities. The job fair enabled effective engagement between recruiters and job seekers, enhancing employment prospects.

3. Interview & Selection Process

Interviews were conducted across multiple designated venues within the campus. Candidates were guided and managed by volunteers. Companies conducted screening and selection rounds on-site. The structured process ensured smooth coordination and efficient handling of large candidate



volumes. Candidates received direct feedback and insights from recruiters regarding skills and job expectations.

4. Coordination & Support

The event was supported by the Placement Team, student volunteers, housekeeping, and maintenance teams. Continuous coordination ensured proper management of candidate flow, interview scheduling, and infrastructure support. The event was executed seamlessly with effective logistical and operational support.

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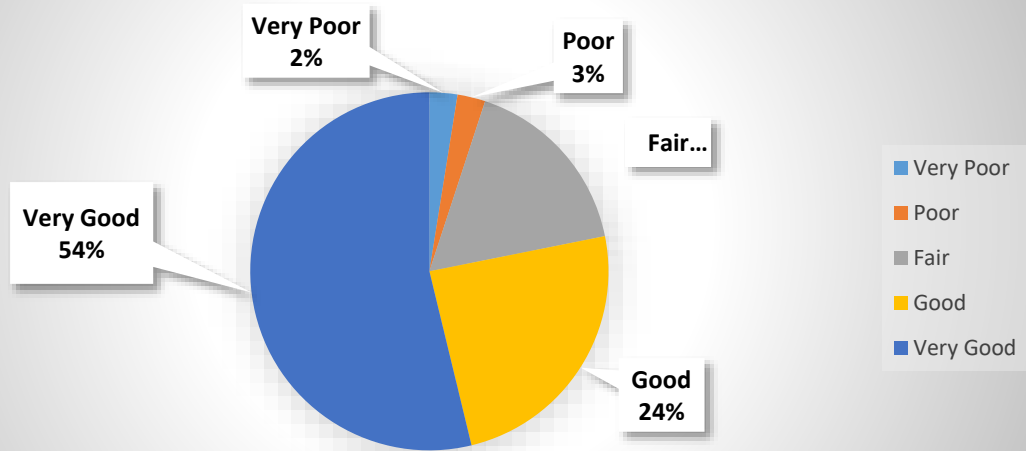

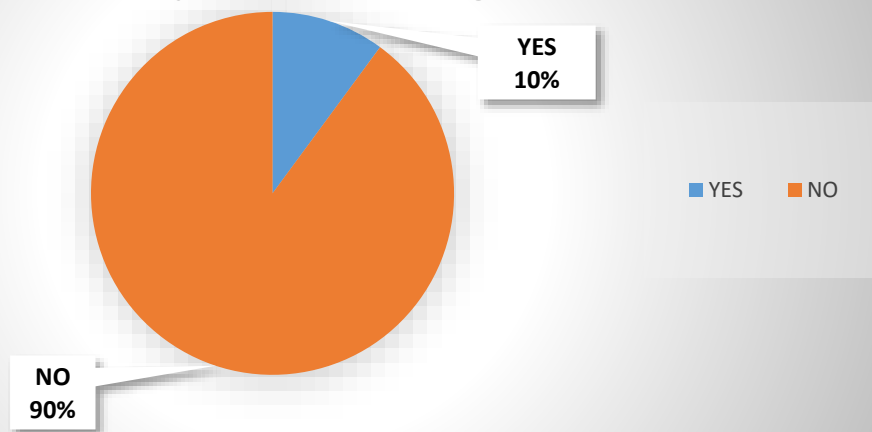

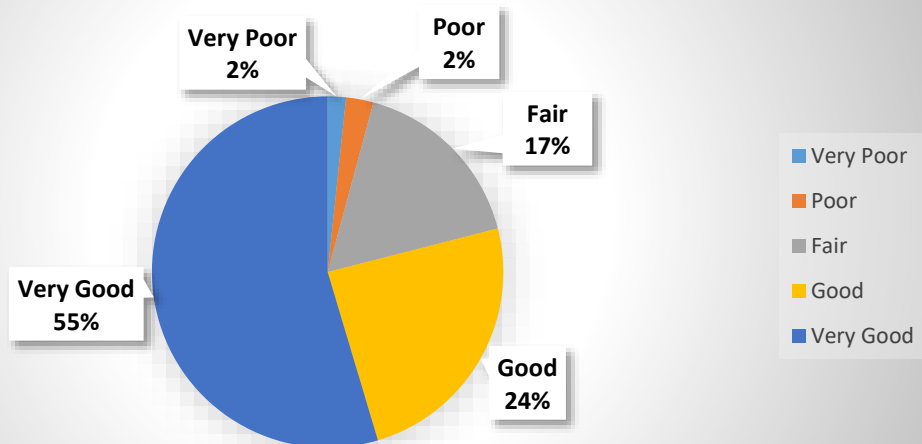
Rate the overall Experience of the Job Fair
