Developing Edible fruit garden at School

Program Introduction:

Acharya Institution of Graduate Studies has been selected as one of the Participating Institution under UBA project from June, 2018 and adopted 4 villages for their overall development through intervention of facilitation.

At present, working with 4 + 2 new villages (Kalathamahalli & Doddabyalakere) of four panchayaths (Alur, Hesaraghatta, H C Halli and Kasaghattapura extended two villages in the same panchayaths.

Theme of the Event:

Conducting celebration of World Environment Day by developing edible fruits garden Government Higher Primary School DODDA BYALAKERE, KASAGHATTAPURA Panchayath

Mr. Padmanabhan – Panchayath development officer, KASAGHATTAPURA Panchayati, Rural Development Panchayat Raj Department (CV enclosed).

The resource person has taken the interactive session on basics of environment and life cycle with food chain with an example. Also, focused on save the water and soil conservation by using posters. Later on, discussed about Water pollution, Air pollution and critical issues of environment by using question and answers methods with an example. The session was very useful as all the students and community people expressed.

Detailed Report: Organized Under: UNNAT BHARATH ABHIYAN (UBA) Project;

World Environment Day is celebrated globally to promote environmental awareness and encourage actions for the protection and conservation of nature. The program has created awareness among school students, School Development and Monitoring Committee (SDMC) members, and the local community regarding environmental conservation, sustainable practices, and the importance of maintaining a clean and healthy environment in the following given tasks and activities;

- 1.Plantation Drive within the school premises.
- 2.Environmental Awareness Rally involving students, teachers, SDMC members, and villagers.
- 3.Cleanliness Campaign in and around the school and village.
- 4.Student Competitions such as speeches, essay writing, and drawing on environmental themes.
- 5.Distribution of saplings and environmental awareness materials to participants.

Formal Session, Resource Person Invite for talk:

Shri. Padmanab, Panchayath Development Officer, Kasaghattapura GP has given the importance of nature for future generation and technical inputs and protection of plants in the campus. Awareness sessions on environmental conservation, waste management, and water conservation.

Participation:

The inaugural function was started at 10.30 am with prayer by students and welcomed by Annapurna madam. On the stage, Principal, Acharya Institute of Graduate Studies, Head Madam, Panchayath Development officer and presented and inaugurated the program by watering to the plants as well as lightening the lamp. All students were involved actively and oath (pledge) by students and others also involved in this process

Secondly, UBA coordinator has briefed about UBA project and motivated all to stop usage of plastic bags and other plastic items. Also, he distributed the cotton bags for all and taken pledge by all for stop the usage of cotton bags in future.

Plantation Drive:

After the inauguration, all are involved in the plantation drive and totally 80 plants were planted by Guests, Teachers, NCC and MSW students and SDMC members along with community.

In the theme of kitchen Garden and Edible fruit garden, all plants are related to fruits, vegetable and herbs (Medicinal Plants) like mango, chicku, Goa, Custer apple Kari leaf, Drumstick, pomegranate (Dalimbe) Jamun (Nerale fruit) lemon and other flower plants.

Future course of action:

1. Protection of plants with tree guards
2. Watering at least once in 3 days during the rainy session and once in two days in the summer.
3. Formation of small groups (consisting of 3 students) for watering and monitoring the plants.
4. Applying farm yard manure and compost to each plant
5. Plan to start kitchen garden besides the school to grow vegetables and leafy and creeper types of vegetables for usage their own mid-day meal.
6. To start Bala Jyothi program with association of ISAF foundation
7. To start skills of basics of tailoring to the interested students and drop outs of the same school from the UBA project by providing two tailoring machines.
8. Teaching of English with Grammar for the 7th standard students
