- 10) Concluded successfully with positive feedback and active participation from students and faculty members.

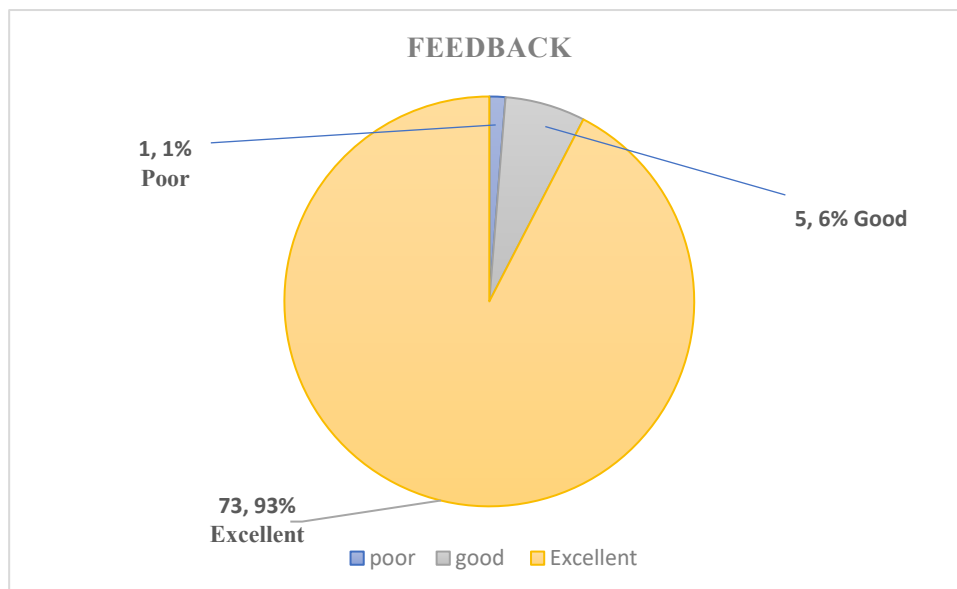
### **Conclusion and Audience Feedback Summary:**
