- 1. Government approval for the academic year 2021-22, subject to the condition that the current course / combination will be limited to 20% of the student's enrollment in addition to the approved student intake.
- 2. B.A and B. Sc 1st year (first and second semesters) in accordance with the National Education Policy 2020 allows students to choose the subject instead of the combinations in the respective courses. Accordingly, these courses are allotted in the college's approved combinations, considering the student size of each subject. Balancing the subject admission limit to the maximum possible level for the academic year
- 3. Operating in excess of 50% of the total approved student size of the College in relation to the Open Elective.
- 4. This incorporation notification is subject to amendment clauses issued by the Government / University from time to time.

Special Note: The report of the Local Inquiry Committee for the academic year 2021-22 is attached. The college required to submit a follow-up report on the deficiencies and shortcomings reported in the Local Inquiry Committee report within fifteen days. If the college fails in submitting the report, the application for renewal of affiliation for the academic 2022 -23 will not be accepted.

- Conditions:
 - 1. The terms and conditions given by the Local Inquiry Committee to be followed.
 - 2. The University does not accept an additional admission intake which should not exceed the prescribed student admission intake.
 - 3. No Courses / Courses should be enhanced by the college without prior approval from the university.

- 4. Reservation orders issued by the Government from time to time must be strictly followed when making admission of students to these degree courses.
- 5. The college shall comply with the Code of Conduct and Regulations issued by the University from time to time regarding the teaching and non-teaching staff of the college. Students must be admitted in accordance with the college's university notification and not in violation of the eligibility norms set by the university.
- 6. Except for admission and other fees set by the University from time to time for postgraduate courses 50 % of allotted student (100% for government colleges) The College should make admission for the students sponsored by the university.
- 7. Vaishakha v/s Rajasthan State Government in respect of the case dated 13/08/1997 as per the Supreme Court order; it is a punishable offense for sexual harassment by any person (teaching / non-teaching faculty/ governing body) or from student to any women / student in college. If any person / student are found involved in such activities, such a person can be redeemed by a job / student. The college shall establish a grievance committee as per the order of the Supreme Court.
- The college should be able to develop courses to the level of developing students academically. The Principals /Management should treat the students and the teaching staff in service with compassion.
- 9. College should not keep records of students above six months without any reason.
- 10. If the students request a transfer letter, the college has to provide the same to the students without giving any trouble. To incur any additional fees, excluding the tuition fee for the unfinished period of that year / semester no permissions is provided as per the rule.
- 11. College fees do not cover any type of capitation fee.
- 12. Kannada must be used in administrative affairs.
- 13. For the academic year 2022-23 colleges have to apply for the affiliation without fail.
- 14. Colleges which have completed 5 years need to apply for NAAC and get accredited.
- 15. Principals of the affiliation colleges have to send the eligible faculty list to the examination board and also have send the faculty for the revaluation without fail, if fails to follow the same the affiliation will be cancelled by the university.
- 16.Affiliated colleges have to confirm curriculum with the subject/combination from the University for the New Admission.
- 16. Affiliation fee should be paid along with 18% GST, GST to be calculated from the 2018-19 to 2021-22 (4 years).
- 17. Every year extension of AICTE approval is must.
- 18. The Institution shall abide by the condition laid down by the AICTE, New Delhi, BCU.
- 19. Admission to MBA and MCA course shall be made as per the seat matrix fixed by the KEA.
