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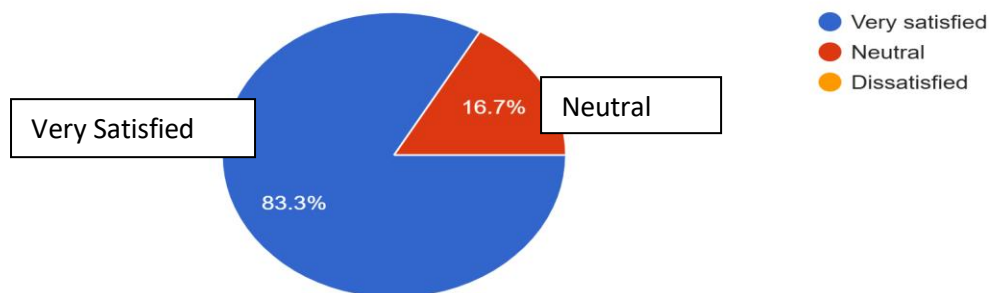

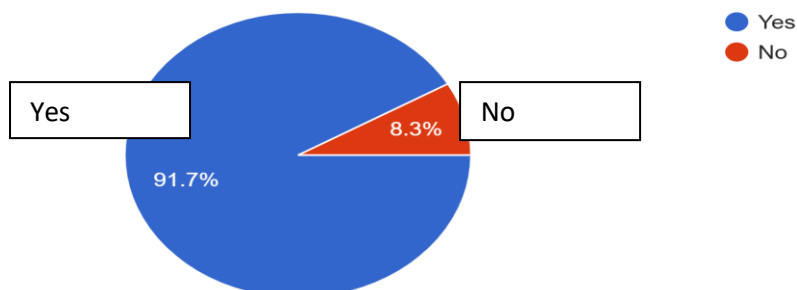
How satisfied were you with the overall structure and organization of the "Chai Pe Charcha" event?

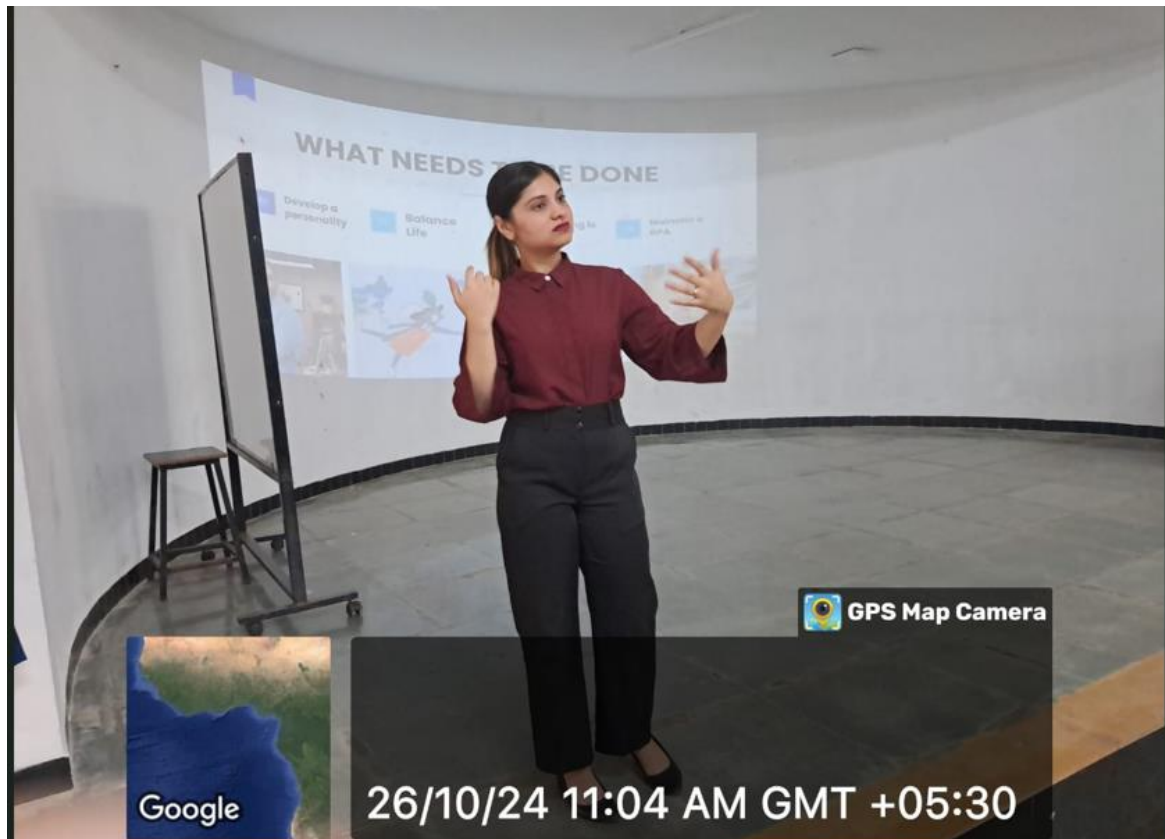

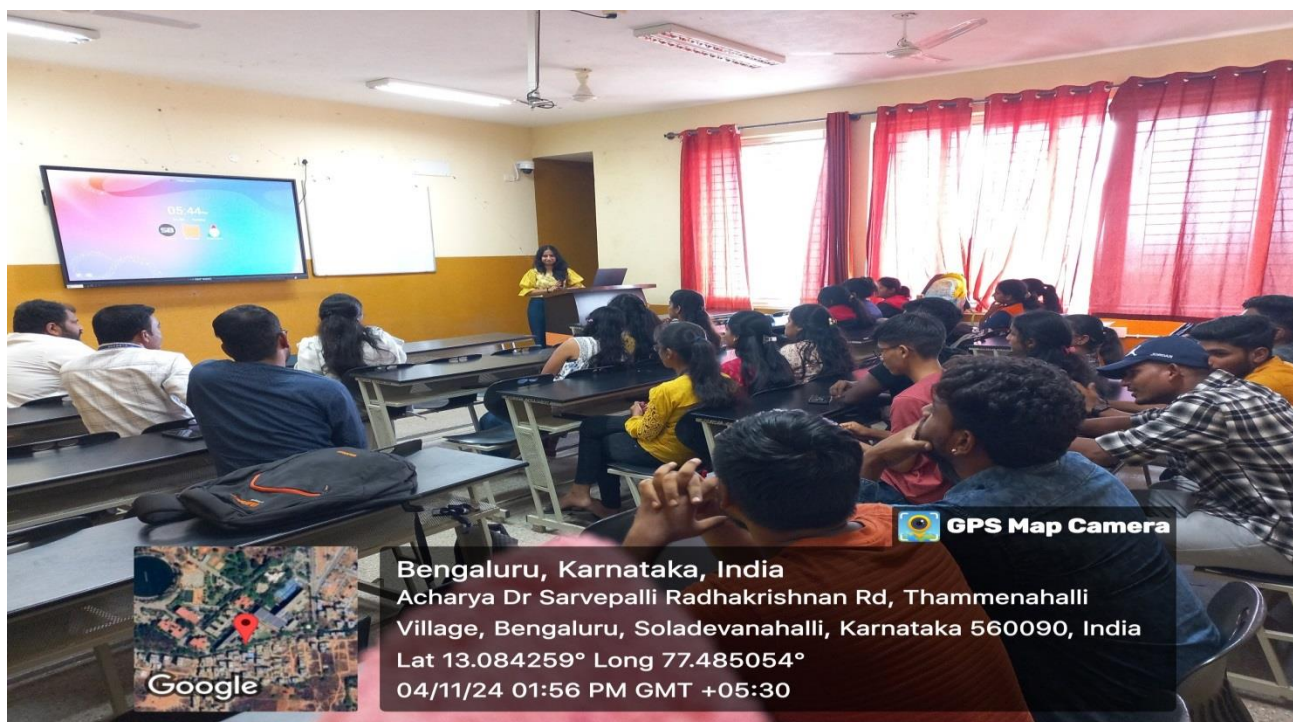
